The Mary Smith Cup: Best exhibit in the Flowers Section

The Barge Inn Cup: The entrant gaining the most points in the Fruit section

The White Horse Cup: The entrant gaining the most points in the Vegetables section

The Collison Cup: The entrant gaining the most points in the Domestic section

The Hodges Cup: The entrant gaining the most points in the Children's section

The AC&DG&CC Cup: The member of the AC&DG&C Club gaining the most points

The Joyce Major Cup: The entrant gaining the most points in the show who lives in the parish and who has never previously won a cup at OUR show

The Altons and Honeystreet Challenge Cup: The entrant resident in the parish of Altons & Honeystreet gaining the most points

The Carson Cup: The entrant gaining the second highest points in the show

The Coronation Cup: The entrant gaining the most points in the show.

SHOW RULES – please read carefully

1. Completed entry forms must be returned to the organisers **before** 9pm on Friday, 7th August: deliver to the labelled box at the Flower Stall in SN8 4JX **OR** copy the form & email **OR** simply email a list of your chosen classes to info@3vevents.org.uk
2. All exhibits to be staged in the Coronation Hall, between 9.00am – 11.00am on Sunday 9th August. **No exhibits will be accepted after 11.00am** and may not be removed from the hall before 4.00pm after prize giving.
3. Entry fee is £1.00 **per section** except for Children's Section (classes G1-G3). Please note: You are very welcome to make several entries in a single class - the more the merrier – but only one of those entries will be awarded points or be considered for a prize.
4. In each class, the correct number of flowers, vegetables etc must be shown.
5. No unauthorised persons to be in the hall whilst judging is in progress.
6. No exhibitors' names to be displayed until judges have made their decision.
7. In classes A15 - A17 and Class E10 the pot plant/chickens must have been in the care of the exhibitor for at least 3 months.
8. Classes E1-E5 & E11 jars/bottles must be labelled with the flavour. No proprietary labels on pots or lids.
9. Classes F1 - F8 the work must have been created within the last 12 months.
10. The judges' decision will be final.
11. Any objections must be made in writing to the organisers by 3pm on the day of the Show.
12. Organisers are only permitted to enter 2 classes per section and may not win any cups.
